

State Health Regulations

1. School physicals and immunization documentation are required for all students entering:
 - a. Pre-School
 - b. Kindergarten
 - c. Sixth Grade
 - d. Students transferring to an Illinois school for the first time. (After enrollment 30 days are given to complete this.)

2. The State of Illinois requires that diabetes screening shall be completed as a required part of each health examination. The rules developed by the Illinois Department of Public Health require that each student, at the time of their physical, be assessed for risk of having or developing Type 2 Diabetes. Results of the diabetes risk assessment must be documented on the Certificate of Child Health examination form.

3. All children enrolling in Kindergarten or an Illinois school for the first time must have an eye examination and present proof of this examination by October 15th of the current school year. This must be completed by a licensed eye physician or optometrist.

4. All students entering Kindergarten, Second, and Sixth or Illinois schools for the first time are required to have an oral health examination (dental exam). A licensed dentist must complete these exams prior to May 15th of the school year. For families that require financial assistance, please call Dentaquest for assistance (888-286-2447). In addition, College of DuPage Dental Hygiene School is a low cost option for exams, x-rays, cleanings and preventive treatment (630-942-3250).

In compliance with state law, Itasca School District 10 will exclude students that have not presented the health office with a physical examination including immunization documentation by October 15 of the current school year.
