Week of Nov. 7-11, 2016

Language Arts/Reading: Learning high frequency popcorn word "go" and reading popcorn word book, We Go.

How to help: Your child will be assessed on the first nine popcorn words we have learned so far - I, can, the, we, see, a, like, to, and. We will share the results with you at parent teacher conferences.

Math: Number concepts for 3 and 4.

How to help: Have your child use toys, pennies, cereal or some other object to make sets. Put pieces of paper down with different numbers on each and have them count out objects and put the set by that piece of paper.

Social Studies: Tuesday we will be talking about Election Day (keeping it on the very light side about the real election). We will be focusing on our own special classroom voting. Friday we will be learning about Veterans Day. We will be discussing the flag as the symbol of our country and we will be making our own giant "handmade" flag. We have a Veteran's day assembly on Friday, November 11th 9:45 a.m. Afternoon students are invited to come with their parents.

How to help: Have your child make his/her own American flag with objects from around the house...popsicle sticks...put stickers on a paper or just use crayons or markers (if you are a Pinterest person there are some cute ideas on there).

Fire Safety: On Tuesday we will be having members from the Itasca Fire Department coming to Benson to talk to us about fire safety.

How to help: Please review what fire safety looks like in your own home with your child.
