Week of December 12-16, 2016

Language Arts/Reading: Learning the high frequency popcorn word "my" and reading popcorn word book, We See It.

How to help: At the end of next week (before winter break) we will be sending home an assessment sheet that will show the 13 popcorn words we have learned so far with a score of how many your child can recognize. If there are any your child needs to work on please refer to the "Popcorn Word Fun" packet for ideas. If you need another copy please just let your child's teacher know.

Math: Finishing up unit on comparing numbers

How to help: Come up with a way to do a countdown to Christmas. Put numbers on the fridge and take one down everyday or make a paper chain and take one off everyday.

Science: Winter! Wednesday, December 21st is the first official day of winter. We will be talking about how weather, plants and animals change in the winter.

How to help: When we get back from winter break we will be starting our winter word wall. Brainstorm with your child as many winter words as you can. Even write them on a piece of paper and keep it handy and if we do a word at school that is on your child's paper, he/she can go home and check it off the list.

Other: Another flier will be coming home in your child's folder giving you all the details you need to know about the winter program on December 15th. Remember that next week we will be assessing your child on his/her birthday (month and day...they don't need to know the year). The week of January 3rd we will assess phone number and the week of January 9th we will assess address.
